



# Cafeteria Point of Sale Debit System

## Franklin Borough School District



- Your school uses a computerized point of sale system in the cafeteria. Parents can make payments online.
- This system allows for account purchase of meals and snacks.
- Parents may pay in advance for purchases.
- All students will be issued a Personal Identification Number (PIN) which corresponds to their food service account and which

should be kept confidential.

- The 2021-2022 school students will receive **free breakfast and lunch** any money on account or placed on account can be used to purchase ala carte items such as chips, ice cream,
- Any prepaid meals on a meal card from the previous year will automatically be put on the student's account.
- Any remaining funds at the end of the school year are available for use in September or may be transferred to a sibling's account.

### Online Payments

- Log on to [PaySchools.com](https://www.pay.com)
- Select the "Sign-Up" option from the menu
- The screens will guide you through the process to establish your account
- The internet convenience fee is a percentage for credit cards and a flat fee for ACH transaction

### Advantages

- A cashless system is a new safety measure to prevent the Covid-19 virus from spreading.
- Students will be able to place funds on their accounts by using Check, online payment or Cash, if cash is used at the register the change will be placed on the students account. No change will be given at the register
- Students have more time to eat

- Payments can be made 24/7 online
