For optimal product quality, serve within 8 minutes. Conventional Oven: 1. Preheat oven to 350°F. 2. Place frozen pouches, picture side up, in a single layer on baking sheet. Heat for 17-18 minutes. 3. Allow product to cool 2 minutes prior to serving. For optimal product quality, serve within 8 minutes. *Do not exceed 350°F. Do not allow pouches to contact any interior oven surfaces. Microwave: 1. Place 1 frozen pouch, picture side up, on a microwave-safe dish. 2. Heat on HIGH for 35 seconds.
